## CALL FOR ENTRIES 5th edition of the FIFAC From 10 to 14 October 2023

## Film registrations are open for the 2023 edition of the FIFAC. International festival dedicated to the best in creative documentary and digital content, the FIFAC will be held in Saint-Laurent du Maroni (French Guiana) from 10 to 14 October 2023 and online on the festival website.

This October, during 5 days, the festival will bring together directors, producers, broadcasters, the general public and schoolchildren around a selection of works from the Amazon-Caribbean area. On the agenda: original films, meetings, screenings, debates, master classes, professional events and festive moments...

The competition is open to films produced from 1 January 2022 onwards, which concern the regions of Guyana, Amazonia and the Caribbean and which deal with a wide range of themes: society, economy, ethnology, animals, history, culture and heritage.

The festival opens its selection to two types of production:

Creative documentaries (short and feature films) and digital documentary creations, intended for viewing on tablet, phone or computer: web docs, web series (interactive experiences, animations, works in virtual reality or 360°, experimental montages).

The films selected for competition will compete for 6 prizes:

Grand Prix FIFAC-France Télévisions / Jury Prize / Best Short Film Prize / High School Prize / Best Digital Content Prize / Audience Prize.
